CAPIS Continues Support Young Women's Preparatory Network STEAM Challenge

According to the Office of Educational Research and Improvement, girls tend to drop out of the STEAM academic pipeline earlier than boys, with many losing interest in these subjects during middle school and high school. YWPN gives young women the academic and leadership skills to achieve success in college and in life. The program's success is striking: 100% of its students who graduate from high school are accepted at a college or university.

CAPIS supports various charities, including Sarah's Circle, a non-profit organization with a mission of serving women who are homeless or in need of a safe space. On February 28, we sponsored its annual Winter Walk. For nearly three decades, "Winter Walk: A Mile in Her Shoes" has rallied support for women who are homeless in Chicago. By highlighting the extreme hardships women who are homeless face during Chicago's harsh winter months, Winter Walk is an opportunity to make a lasting impact on the lives of these women.
